Power (Greek: Dunamis)

Power $\equiv$ Ability

- Ability
- Strength
- Might
- Capacity
- God’s ability working through you

1. Jesus Is Our Example

Matthew 3:16–17

- Jesus was baptized in water.
- The Holy Spirit came upon Him.
- The Father affirmed Him.

Luke 4:14

Luke 4:18

“The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me...”

The anointing empowered Jesus to:

- Preach the Gospel.
- Heal the brokenhearted.
- Set captives free.
- Fulfill the Father’s purpose.

The anointing is always connected to God’s purpose.

2. The First Miracle

John 2:1–11 — The Wedding at Cana

Mary believed.

- She was the first person to believe Jesus could do the impossible.
- Faith sees before everyone else

Jesus said:

“My hour has not yet come.”

Mary told the servants:

“Do whatever He tells you.” (*John 2:5*)

3. The Anointing Gives Direction

Jesus gave the instruction:

- Fill the waterpots with water.
- They obeyed.
- The miracle followed.

obedience will bring your miracle

- The anointing gives direction.
- Faith obeys.
- Obedience releases God's power.

4. The Anointing Empowers You to Fulfill God's Purpose

The Holy Spirit empowers you to:

- Hear God's voice.
- Receive His direction.
- Follow His instruction.
- Accomplish what He has called you to do.
